## About the play...

*Crush* is an alien invasion rom-com that is also a 21st century response to Thornton Wilder's classic *Our Town*. *Crush* is a mash-up: funny, heartbreaking and full of unforgettable characters. It's a play about what it means to love someone and what it means to be human. It involves a small town in the California desert falling on hard times, a high school theatre group staging *Our Town*, love in many flavors, and an alien invasion, headed by a lead alien who has six bodies, five of which are invisible to *almost* everyone. When completing the form, please only use a No. 2 pencil. Completely bubble in the appropriate circle, which applies to your circumstance. Make sure you SIGN the form before returning it with your student.

Check for current vacancies on the left hand-side or Start an application as an Internal Applicant. This is found on the Welcome page below the two hands shaking.

You should start an application as an external applicant if you have never work for us before. You will need to create a log-in which is your email address and a pass-code. Once you have completed your initial profile, you will need to proceed to page 4 and 5 of the application. You will see various positions that include "Substitute/Temporary" and click the position for 'Substitute Teacher' then complete the work history for the past 10 years. This includes paid and volunteer work as well as periods of unemployment.

You must also list three professional references from your most recent supervisor, manager, professor or university adviser. We do not accept references from friends, or co-workers. The final item is a copy of your Official college/university transcript. This document should be scanned and attached to your application. You can go back at any time to edit or make changes to your application.

Please submit an application at your convenience and contact me after your application has been submitted and all three electronic references have responded back on your behalf. Be sure to include their correct email address and complete contact information. You may view the status of their response at any time by logging into your application to check.


