Murray Hill Middle School is celebrating Read Across America Month in March with a Bookmark Design Contest. Submissions are encouraged from all current Murray Hill students. Completed bookmarks should be turned in to the submission box in the media center.

CONTEST RULES

Draw/paint your bookmark in the template provided. You may use colored pencil, marker, crayon, paint, chalk, pen-and-ink, on paper only. Make sure your design will be bold enough to be copied. Bookmarks must be handmade. We will not accept computer generated illustrations for this contest.

We cannot publish trademarked images such as cartoon characters due to copyright laws. Please make sure that your work is original.

Bookmark Criteria

In order to qualify for the contest, bookmarks must include the following:

- The name of our school: Murray Hill Middle School or MHMS
- Must reference books or reading.
- The year 2020 or '20.
- A design on the front of the bookmark only.
- The design must fit on the 2 X 6 template provided by your teacher.
- The designer's name can only be written on the back side of the bookmark.

Submissions are due by December 20th but may be turned in earlier. Each student can only submit one design.

Judging

MHMS students and staff will be voting for the winning bookmark. All bookmarks will be on display in the media center during the month of January. Each student and staff member will be able to vote for just one bookmark.

Prizes

- The prestige of having your bookmark printed and available in the library. The 1st place bookmark will be professionally printed. Second and third place bookmarks will be printed on cardstock and also be made available in the library.
- Designers of the top three bookmarks will receive gift cards to Barnes and Noble.
- Winners will be announced on Monday, March 2nd on #MHTV News.
