# **PARCC Testing**

Throughout the month of March, students will take the PARCC Performance Based Assessments for both English/Language Arts and Mathematics. These interactive computer-based assessments are designed to reflect the full range of content and skills found in the Common Core State Standards.

This week, students practiced taking the assessment through the PARCC website to provide them with the opportunity to practice test items and become familiarized with the online tools that are designed for the test. MHMS PARCC Assessments are scheduled to take place on the following dates:

March 11, 12, & 13 Grade 6 online PARCC

March 16, 17, & 18 Grade 7 online PARCC

March 19, 20 and 23 Grade 8 online PARCC

#### From The Health Room

#### \*\*IMPORTANT - NEW IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS\*\*

Effective the first day of school, 2015-2016, 1 dose of Tdap vaccine and 1 dose of Meningococcal vaccine will be required by the state of Maryland for **all students entering Grade 7**. If we **DO NOT** receive proof of immunization, your child will be unable to attend school. Many students may have already received these immunizations, but the Health Room may not have the **updated** immunization record. Please contact your child's doctor and send/fax in an **updated** copy of your child's immunizations to the Health Room. Our fax # is (301) 317-5048.


