Although students will be provided with a graphing calculator for use in school and have the ability to borrow one for out of school use, students are best served by having a personal calculator and becoming very familiar with how it is used to address a number of different types of mathematics problems. Students who go on to take mathematics courses in college will often be able to use the same calculator for college coursework.
